USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Entries. (1) Enter online if you wish to pay by credit card OR (2) Fill out the official entry form and mail or hand-deliver to the show secretary along with full payment (check or money order payable to DONIDA FARM, US funds) and all documentation. E-mailed entries are not complete until payment received. No phoned or faxed entries. Copies of the horse's registration papers and all membership cards must accompany entry, as well as Verification of Qualifications form for Region Championship entries. Entries postmarked prior to opening date will incur a three-day penalty; entries postmarked after midnight on closing date will be accepted if space if available; post entry fees will be assessed.

Entries, Late Qualifying. Do not enter a championship class until your horse is qualified. EXCEPTION: ALL Dressage and Western Dressage Championship ride times will be preassigned. To reserve time for a horse not yet qualified, see instructions. Horses/Equitation riders/showmanship handlers qualifying after close of entries have until noon the day prior to the championship to enter—or convert a provisional entry—without penalty.

Entries, Payment for.. Mailed entries: enclose check or money order payable in US funds to DONIDA FARM. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Open checks are not allowed for the initial entry. If an open check is sent, it will be closed for the amount due at the time the entry is processed and will be deposited. An open check may be left in the show office during the show to cover post entries and other incidentals. Entries received without payment will be assessed an incomplete entry fee and will be subject to post entry penalties if payment is postmarked after close of entries. You will be notified via a confirmation e-mail of any balance due, i.e., math errors, misunderstanding of fees, or failure to include post entry fees. Amounts owed must be paid before numbers are released. By signing the entry form and/or submitting entries to us you agree to pay all fees due and understand refunds will not be made except for reasons listed in the published refund policy. If in doubt about fees or entry deadlines, phone before sending your entry. Submission of entry to us is your intent to show and acceptance of our show rules. All debts incurred at the show must be settled before removing a horse from the grounds.

Entries, Refusal/Removal of. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. The show committee reserves the right to remove any person and/or his horse from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages. Refunds will not be given to exhibitors evicted for cause.

Entries, Wait listed. Every effort will be made to accommodate all who want to participate in the **SALUTE! Show.** Entries will be accepted in post- mark order. Since there are a limited number of ride times in individually judged classes, those classes may fill before the closing date. If that happens, entries for filled classes will be placed on a waiting list. Per GR915.3(a): Ties regarding the waiting list order for entries postmarked on the same day will be broken by lot, said drawing to be held at the ad- dress of the show secretary at 7PM on Monday following close of entries.

Entry Confirmation will be sent via email to the legible email address on your entry form. Please review it as soon as it arrives to avoid unpleasant surprises when you arrive at the show office.

Entry Numbers (Back or Bridle). Each horse shall be assigned an entry number which will be used throughout the weekend.

Refunds. Entries cancelled prior to the show's closing date will be fully refunded except for the Office Fee. Entries cancelled after closing date due to illness or injury require presentation of a doctor or veterinary statement (on official letterhead) for refund. The certificate must be received by the show secretary no later than noon of the day prior to the start of competition; such refund will include 50% of class fee Office Fee, which is non-refundable. No refunds will be made if notice of cancellation is received later than noon of the day prior to the start of competition. No refunds will be made if the entry is a no-show. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that all or part of the competition is cancelled due to a storm, acts of God, illness, accident or other emergency at the show.

Refunds for improperly entered classes only in cases of secretary error.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (AHA, USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, riders, handlers, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

Camping. Permit required, \$20 per night per occupied unit (tent, trailer, RV). No hookups. Check facility map at the Welcome Barn to locate designated camping areas. Showers available for campers only, BYO towels and soap. Campgrounds must be 'horse-free', please.

Dogs. If it is not possible to leave your dogs at home, please remember this is a private facility. Purchase a \$30 Dog Permit at the Welcome Barn or show office. Dogs must be tied or kenneled at campsite, in tack stall, or otherwise restrained all times; no off-leash anywhere on grounds. Permitted dogs must wear their fashion scarf (issued with permit). Dogs with scarves allowed in the infield of the race track. Dogs are not welcome in the show office. Dogs are not allowed in the vendor, concession, competition, warmup, and spectator areas. Person on the other end of the leash is responsible for picking up and properly disposing of dog's deposits. \$50 fine and removal of competitor from show grounds with no refunds may result from infractions. All fee collection (registration or fine) is between the dog owner and Donida Farm. USEF rule GR1301.6: "Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards."

Feed & hay will be available for purchase on site; limited selection, market price.

Food Vendor. Concessions on the grounds: breakfast, lunch, snacks, and beverages available for the entire show.

Footing. See Arenas above.

Parking. Main barn/arena area for loading and unloading only. Trailer parking, spectator parking and camping areas designated; maps posted at Welcome Barn and Show Office **Keep fire lanes open at all times.**

Security. Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure valuables and their stall areas. AHA, Donida Farm, their members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

Sharps containers for medical waste (needles, syringes, etc.) are mounted on or in each barn and stable block. A \$100 fine per violation will be passed on to the violator for medical waste found in your area or if you are found disposing of materials improperly.

Stabling. All stalls are 10x10 with full doors. Permanent stalls in Barns B-E; remaining stalls are 10x10 puckboard portables; shedrow style, covered, with full doors, dirt floors, no mats. A limited number of lockable tack rooms are available. Stalls will be pre-assigned and assignments posted at the show office and at the Welcome Barn at the facility entrance. All horses must be stalled, one horse per stall; no haul-ins, no shared stalls and no unweaned foals. Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors. Stalls are available from 1PM Wednesday through 6PM Sunday. Bring your own stall cleaning equipment, water buckets, and feed. Stalls include initial bedding. Additional preordered bedding will be waiting in your assigned stall. Purchase additional bedding (baled shavings) at show office. Use of other bedding will incur \$35/day removal fee. No stall construction changes allowed. Riders will be charged damage fees; \$25 fee for nails in tack stalls.

No microwaves, refrigerators, hot plates, crock pots, or other electric appliances may be used in tack stalls or stabling area. Fans are permitted as long as cord is safely stowed off ground and away from horses. For horse and competitor safety, no extension cords crossing aisles. No pop-up tents or umbrellas or any other materials may block the aisles or driveways; **aisles must be kept clear.**

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK AND THE HANDBOOK OF THE ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS TO FAMILIARIZE THEMSELVES WITH THESE RULES. All exhibitors, by completing their entry, acknowledge and attest that they have read and understand all terms of these rules, wherever listed in this prize list.

Admission to the Competition, On-Deck and Schooling Areas. No person will be allowed in the competition ring except participants in the class, judges, and show photographer/videographer. There shall be no conduct in the on-deck area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses, handlers, or spectators. No one is permitted on foot in the under saddle warm-up and schooling arenas.

Age of Horse. For competition purposes, a horse is considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the foaling date. A junior horse is one that is five years of age or younger. A horse must be at least 36 months of age (from actual foaling date) to compete under saddle in the Dressage section.

Announcements. Official updates to this prize list, ride times and other announcements will be posted at www.DonidaFarm.com. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to secure the most current version of posted show information. Postings will also be made on the Donida Farm Arabian Sport Horse *SALUTE!* Facebook page. Starting the day prior to competition, announcements will be posted at the show office

Awards. for *SALUTE!* classes will be given to first place and ribbons through 6 places, to 8 in Equitation. Rail classes (Sport Horse Under Saddle, Show Hack, Carriage Driving, Hunter) will be pinned in the ring. Please bring your blue ribbon to the Awards Tent to claim your award. Individual classes (Dressage, Western Dressage, In-Hand). When the class is complete, results will be posted at the Awards Tent, where you may claim your scoresheets, ribbons & awards. **A full Top Five placement will be awarded in Region Championships**. All ribbons and awards must be claimed at the show. — If you leave early, please make arrangements for someone to pick up your scoresheets, ribbons and awards from the Awards Tent.

Change of Handler/Rider. Please fill out a handler/rider change form, including signatures, correct association numbers and required documentation, in the show office prior to the start of the class. This will ensure that points are recorded correctly for qualifying purposes.

Changes to Schedule or Venue. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions. All changes will be posted on the announcement board at the office and the appropriate announcements made during the competition. Classes with no entries by closing date may be cancelled. Competition management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. Show management reserves the right to add or substitute judges as required. Upon receipt of the preliminary ride schedule, it is the rider's responsibility to notify Show Management if they are NOT eligible to show for a substitute or added judge.

Class Calls. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class. The public address system is a courtesy to the exhibitors and its function cannot be guaranteed. No refunds will be made solely because of sound system inadequacy or failure.

Coach is defined as an adult who receives remuneration for having or sharing the responsibility for instructing, teaching, schooling, or advising a rider, driver, handler or vaulter in equestrian skills. That person must sign the entry and provide proof of USEF membership if coaching on the show grounds.

Coggins. See Veterinary Health Requirements, Out-of-State.

member as Owner. "Bill of Sale" & "Pending" are not acceptable

Delay of Class / "Gate Hold". In classes where horses compete collectively, when it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor such request shall be made to the Paddock Manager (gate person) prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Gate holds are only allowed for group classes; "...in classes where horses compete individually, failure to check in with the Paddock Manager or to enter the competition arena at the assigned time will result in elimination." [GR831.1]

When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued.

- a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate.
- b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed and the class is deemed concluded.
- c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained.
- d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed and judging will commence.
- e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between)
- f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant.

Disputes not covered by the rules. This horse show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation and the Arabian Horse Association. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules of USEF and AHA, it shall be referred to the Show Manager for resolution.

General Information, please read it

Drug and Medication Rule. Refer to USEF Chapter 4. Medication Report Forms are available from the Show Steward and may be filed online.

Gate Hold. See Delay of class.

Judging System. Single judge system; judge's decision in all classes final.

Junior Exhibitor. An individual who has not reached his or her 19th birthday as of December 1st of the previous calendar year is a Junior Exhibitor ("Junior") in the Arabian Division. All Junior Exhibitors are considered Amateurs for competition purposes. [AR110.6]

Management Rights. Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of any incident in the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulation shall be decided by Show Management and the Show Management's decision shall be final. Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries for cause, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel awards without claim to damages; to change, cancel or combine classes, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, or to change rings or rotate judges. Management may deny entry to any competitor if the competitor has outstanding debt to the sponsoring organization. See USEF rule GR914 Refusal of Entries and GR915 Limiting Entries

Vehicles, motorized. in accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Order of Go for Sport Horse In-Hand classes will be determined by the gate person with consideration to handlers presenting multiple horses or exhibiting in other arenas. See Scheduling, Class Calls.

Protests. Protests may be filed as set forth in USEF GR603.

Qualification for Regional Classes. See the current AHA Handbook for comprehensive rules, in particular COMP 1202. Regional Rules and COMP 1204. Methods for Qualifying. Look for qualification reports on the AHA website under Member Programs & Services. Horses previously qualified and entered after closing date will be assessed post entry fees. Horses (or Equitation riders) qualifying after close of entries, see Entries, Late Qualifying.

Exhibitors are responsible for ascertaining their qualifications. Please make certain that you have enough qualification points for the classes you enter and complete a Qualification Record Form for each horse entered. Do not enter a championship class until your horse is qualified. No refunds will be made for improperly entered classes.

Refunds. Entries cancelled prior to the show's closing date will be fully refunded except for the Office Fee. Entries cancelled after closing date due to illness or injury require presentation of a doctor or veterinary statement (on official letterhead) for refund. The certificate must be received by the show secretary no later than noon of the day prior to the start of competition; such refund will include 50% of class fees, 50% of stabling fees and 100% of all other fees except the Office Fee, which is non-refundable. No refunds will be made if notice of cancellation is received later than noon of the day prior to the start of competition. No refunds will be made if the entry is a no-show. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that all or part of the competition is cancelled due to a storm, acts of God, illness, accident or other emergency at the show. Refunds for improperly entered classes only in cases of secretary error.

Returned Checks / Denied Credit Cards A check returned or credit card denied by the bank for any reason will incur a \$50 fee per occurrence. No checks will be processed a second time. To retain entries, fees plus penalty must be paid by money order, cashier's check or cash within 7 days of notification. Entries received without valid payment will not be processed until full payment is received and will be subject to post entry penalties if payment is postmarked after close of entries. Show packets will not be released until all debts are settled. In the event a check is returned by the bank after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913.

Scoring Errors. If a mathematical scoring error on the score sheet is discovered, it must be reported to Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last scored class of that competition day the error will stand with no change in class placings.

Scratched Classes. After the close of entries, canceling a horse's entry in one or more classes is a 'scratch'. No fees will be refunded. Please scratch horses with the Show Secretary prior to the class to avoid penalty. If you don't show up for an assigned ride time, this Competition reserves the right to scratch you from all remaining dressage rides and offer them to other exhibitors. If you are unable or choose not to ride, notify the secretary immediately.

Sweepstakes classes, [\$\$ in class title], are open to all horses, however, prize money will be won only by horses enrolled in the Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes program.

TOC and 'specify level'. TOC = "Test of Choice." You choose which test to ride, but you must declare that test on your entry form. If no test is declared, you will be assigned the highest test of the level. If that isn't what you want, a change fee will apply.

Trainer. USEF defines Trainer as "the adult is responsible for the horse while it is on the show grounds." The parent or guardian of a minor exhibitor must assume the responsibilities of "Trainer." Therefore, every horse does have a Trainer, and that person must sign the entry and provide copies of membership cards or pay associated fees. Parents signing as Trainer for minor children are exempt from association fees.

General Information, please read it

Unsportsmanlike Conduct will not be tolerated and management reserves the right to bar any person acting in a manner deemed improper, unethical, dishonest, unsportsmanlike or intemperate, or prejudicial to the best interests of the sport. USEF GR702 will apply. Note GR 702.1.e: [Violations of this rule include] "Any act committed or remark made in connection with the competition considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the character or integrity of the licensed officials, approaching a judge before or after a decision without first obtaining permission from the show committee or steward/technical delegate, inspecting a judge's card without the judge's permission, or public verbal abuse of competition officials."

Veterinary Health Requirements. USEF Vaccination Rule (GR845). Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the Vaccination Record is missing or incomplete. Whether the horse is vaccinated by a veterinarian or by an owner or agent, or is exempt for medical or age reasons, documentation is required; see GR845 for details. Download report form from USEF and bring completed, signed document(s) to the competition with the horse.

Out-of-State Horses. Washington State requires current (6 month) health certificate from state of origin, horse ID papers and Coggins test. The regulations do change periodically. Washington State Department of Agriculture, (360) 902-1878, has the most recent information. Donida Farm is not requiring health certificates or Coggins for this competition.

All ribbons and awards must be claimed at the show.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in Regular Competitions, all classes at Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA **Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes,** 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF Non-Member Participation. If proper COMPETING (not FAN) membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such membership, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45 (GR1309.2b) Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes.

Amateur Certification. To show in an amateur class, an adult competitor must provide proof of current USEF membership with AMATEUR certification. Walk/trot riders are exempt. Only current USEF/ EC COMPETING members may obtain AMATEUR certification. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members, nor for members of Equine Canada.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT. Each competitor (this

includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership/Competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per competitor. When an Agent signs for the Owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the Owner and Agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in walk-trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA membership with Competition Card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in leadline classes or parents/ guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)

AHA Competition Card Requirements. Current COMPETITION CARDS for all concerned must be mailed with entry or entry will be considered incomplete. All riders, drivers, owners, agents and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must show proof of AHA COMPETITION level membership or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35 per person. If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) and does not have a current AHA Business membership, a Single Event Membership must be purchased for that entity.

Exhibitors in Walk/Trot SALUTE! classes and Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership (refer to AHA Article 705).

NOTE: AHA does not permit Single Event Memberships for AHA Regional Championship Shows. An AHA COMPETITION membership card is required for all, including walk/trot.

Responsibility

Release of Responsibility. Donida Farm, Don Morin, Gwen and/or David Blake, USEF, USDF, AHA, the Show Management, Show Officials, Show Facilities, their Directors and/or employees and volunteers will not be responsible for any accident and/or loss that may occur to any exhibitor, competitor, agent, horse, and/or Equipment. Washington State Equine Limitation of Liability Act RCW 4.24 applies. Horses, by their inherent nature present a risk of injury, harm or death. Riders represent that they are qualified to participate at the level entered. Each exhibitor is responsible for any injury or harm that may be occasioned to any person, whomsoever, by any horse owned or exhibited by said exhibitor, and shall hold harmless and indemnify any agencies or persons listed above, against all claims or demands, of any nature or kind, that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horses owned or exhibited by them, or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of such horse. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents of their horses. All horses exhibited at these shows participate entirely at the owner's or rider's risk. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage caused by them, their agents, their horses, or their employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly. No horse is allowed on the grounds unless it has been entered in the show and the owner has signed the release waiver on the entry form.

Release of Responsibility, Additional. By signing the entry agreement, I further agree to: release, indemnify and hold harmless USDF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities. I also hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the show management, show committee and members, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

This competition is recognized by USDF for 2018

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where
 those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes
 at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille,
 are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walktrot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Education Membership (EM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form and fax or mail it to the USDF office.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

How to Qualify for a Regional Championship Class

General Requirements

- For Equitation and Showmanship championships, it is the **RIDER/HANDLER** who must qualify: for all others, it is the **HORSE**.
- Qualifications for Region 4 Championships must have been earned within the region (including SALUTE! classes), or at a designated Region 4-qualifying show outside the Region 4 boundaries.
- It's not too late! Qualifications for this show must be earned between January 1, 2017 and the day before the desired championship.
- Qualifications must be earned in AHA-recognized competitions. Dressage, Hunter, Jumper, Hunter Hack and Carriage Pleasure
 Driving qualifications may also be earned at Open (USEF/EC/ADS) competitions by enrolling the horse in the AHA Open Show
 Program. See the AHA website, www.arabianhorses.org, for enrollment and results reporting forms, instructions and fees.
- Points, scores & placings earned in a Regional or National Championship may not be used to qualify for a Regional Championship.

How many points does my horse need?

Most **REGIONAL** championships require 1 or 2 qualifying points. Some don't require any.

- Carriage Pleasure Driving: all championships—no qualification required, just enter before closing date.
- **Dressage**, from any test(s) of the level: Training-Third Level—2 points; Fourth Level & Above—1 point.
- Equitation: Dressage Seat, Hunter over Obstacles, Hunter not to Jump-1 point from a regular eq class, not an AHA Medal class.
- **Hunter/Hunter Hack:** Working Hunter, Hunter Hack—1 point.
- Sport Horse In-Hand: Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Stallions, Open or ATH—1 point; all others—2 points.
- Sport Horse Showmanship: 2 points.
- **Sport Horse Show Hack**: any championship—1 point.
- **Sport Horse Under Saddle**: any championship—2 points.
- Western Dressage: Intro & Level 3—1 point. Basic, Lvl 1 & Lvl 2: Regional & National qualifications waived for 2018.

How does my horse earn points?

• A horse/equitation rider/showmanship handler placing 1st -6th will earn 1 point for him/herself + 1 point for each entry below him. Examples: 1st place in a 12-horse class earns 12 pts; 2nd place earns 11 pts...6th place in that class earns 7 pts. Below 6th = 0 pts. 1st place in a 3-horse class = 3 pts; 2nd place = 2 pts; 3rd place = 1 pt.

Substituting placings or scores for points

- **First or second place** earned in an AHA-recognized competition, regardless of the number of points earned, qualifies for a Regional Championship in that division. (Again, placings in Regional and National Championships can't be used.)
- Dressage horses may also qualify on **scores** earned in AHA-recognized or Open competitions; scores must be on record with AHA. Scores from any test(s) of the level: Training & 1st Levels, 2 scores, minimum 58%; 2nd & 3rd Levels, 2 scores, minimum 55%; 4 & Above, 1 score of at least 50%. (Scores earned in prior Regional and National Championship classes can't be used.)

How do I 'spend' the points?

- Points are valid for the remainder of the calendar year in which they are earned through the following year's Regional and National Championships. You must have enough valid points for all the championship classes you wish to enter at one show, but points may then be 're-used' at future Regional and National Championship shows until they expire.
- Qualifications must be earned in the same division as the championship(s). Hunter, Hunter Hack & Jumper are all different
 divisions, as are Sport Horse In-Hand, Under Saddle & Show Hack. Each Level of Dressage is a different division for qualifying
 purposes.
- Points/scores/placings for an Amateur championship must have been earned with an Amateur rider/driver/handler (junior or adult). Qualifications for a JTR Championship must have been earned with a Junior riding. Note that, except in equitation championships, the qualifications can be earned by a different Amateur or Junior than will ride/handle in the Championship class, because the qualifications belong to the horse, not to the rider. (Equitation riders/showmanship handlers may qualify with a different horse.)
- Points earned with an Amateur rider/handler/driver, whether in an Open or an Amateur class, may be used for either Open or Amateur Championships, or split across both.
 - **Example**: Your Junior horse was ridden by an Amateur in a Sport Horse Under Saddle class (*any* SH U/S class) at an AHA show within the region last year. It was an eight-horse class, and they placed 3rd, so your horse has 6 points. You can use two of those points for the Sport Horse Under Saddle Jr Horse Championship and, because the points were earned by an Amateur, two more for the ATR Championship. You have two points left over to enter the Sport Horse Under Saddle Open Championship, too!

Deadlines and post-entry fees

- If your horse (or equitation rider or showmanship handler) qualifies for a championship prior to the closing date but you do not enter the championship until after the closing date, you must pay the post-entry fee.
- If your horse (or equitation rider or showmanship handler) does not qualify until after the closing date—for example, in a **SALUTE!** ('pre-show') class— post-entry fees will *not* apply, so long as you enter **BEFORE NOON** of the day following qualification.
- If your horse is not yet qualified for a championship, do not enter it!
 EXCEPTION: Reserve a ride time in a Western Dressage or Dressage Championship.

Disclaimer It is always the exhibitor's responsibility to read and understand competition rules, including qualification requirements. This explanation is intended to provide general guidance; not to replace or amplify the governing rules of this competition as printed in the AHA Handbook. In the event of a conflict between this explanation and the governing rules, the Handbook prevails. Please note that National championships usually require more points, and sometimes higher scores, than Regionals.
